ELECTRONIC PUBLIC ACCESS (EPA) FEE SCHEDULE CHANGE (INFORMATION)

Pursuant to sections 1913, 1914, 1926, 1930, and 1932 of Title 28, United States Code, the Judicial Conference, at its March 16, 2010 session, amended the Electronic Public Access Fee Schedule for the appellate, district, and bankruptcy courts, the United States Court of Federal Claims, and the Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation. The fee schedule was amended to waive fees of less than \$10 in a quarterly billing cycle rather than in a year, and to establish a fee of \$2.40 for access to digital audio files.

The change from a yearly to a quarterly waiver went into effect in March 2010. The digital audio fee change required a CM/ECF modification, which was included in Release 3.4 of the Bankruptcy application and Release 4.2 of the District application.

The PACER billing software and the fee schedule have been updated accordingly.
