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SPECIAL EDITION OFFICIAL BANKRUPTCY FORMS CHANGES EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 2015

Most Official Bankruptcy Forms (except six of the existing forms) are scheduled to be replaced with substantially revised, reformatted and renumbered versions effective December 1, 2015.

The new forms are part of the Advisory Committee's ongoing forms modernization project to make bankruptcy forms easier to read, and to understand, and more likely, generate complete and accurate responses.

The biggest change is with the case opening forms. The new forms introduce different versions of case opening forms for individual debtors and non-individual debtors under three categories of bankruptcy petition - Voluntary Petition, Involuntary Petition, and Petition for Recognition of Foreign Proceeding. The forms for non-individuals eliminate questions that pertain only to individuals and viceversa and use a more open-ended response format. Questions of a similar nature are grouped together and multiple-part instructions have been replaced that are more specific questions. In addition, where possible, the forms for non-individuals parallel how businesses commonly keep their financial records.

The use of these Official Forms will be mandatory beginning December 1, 2015. The Clerk's Office will issue a deficiency notice for any outdated forms filed on or after December 1, 2015. Therefore, attorneys are advised to contact their software vendors to update their software to meet the new form requirements so that the forms can be in place for December 1, 2015, filings. To keep you further abreast of

the new forms changes, an email will go to all attorney filers around mid-November 2015, with a link to Adobe Captivate Learning Modules (ELMs) giving an overview of the changes and updating current ELMs.

AMENDMENTS TO BANKRUPTCY FORMS AND FED. R. BANKR. P. 1007

In addition to the changes to the bankruptcy forms, the Supreme Court adopted amended Rule 1007 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure. Like the form changes, amended Rule 1007 is scheduled to be effective on December 1, 2015, subject to approval by Congress. Rule 1007 was revised to address changes to several form designations referenced in the rule.

E-Z FILING

Since many ECF filers use E-Z filing bankruptcy software, we wanted to let you know that CINgroup will no longer update or support E-Z filing after November 30, 2015, due to the extensive changes to the bankruptcy forms.

It is important to note that the process of opening a new case, whether it is a complete, or somewhat deficient or "bare bones" petition, where most of the case opening documents are to be filed at a later date, the process for opening a new case has not changed. Few of the screens in the ECF Live Database have had information deleted or added, and the process of uploading a new petition remains the same.
