Submission of Proposed Order

The Tip of the Month for July deals with the two-step process for ECF filers to submit Unsigned Proposed Orders to the Court for signature. They must be:

- 1. Uploaded to the docket for interested parties to review; and
- 2. Uploaded to Chambers using Bankruptcy/Adversary Event **Upload Proposed** Order.

On the Court's website are two Electronic Learning Modules (ELMs) for submitting proposed orders directly to Chambers for signature.

Upload Single Order should be used when a hearing has been scheduled or held. You may view the ELM by clicking on this link:
